Enrolment

Please make sure you bring with you a form of identification eg. a Driving Licence, full payment and proof of benefits (if appropriate), otherwise you will not be able to enrol and secure your place on the course.

Fees, Concessions and How to Pay - for Adult Courses

Fees stated are an inclusive fee which include: tuition, examination and registration costs.

Course Specific Charges

For some courses, you may be required to pay for course materials or additional individual fees to Examination Awarding Body organisations. You will be advised of these when you enrol. Where courses are for more than one year, the course fee quoted is for the first year of the course only. Terms and Conditions apply.

Course fees are payable on enrolment by cash, cheque, MasterCard/Visa or American Express. We accept payment by instalments where the total cost of the course is more than £500. This will require an initial payment of 30% payable on enrolment followed by the remainder by four equal instalments.

Advanced Learner Loans

If you are aged 19+ and studying for a Level 3 or higher level course, you can now apply for an Advanced Learner Loan to help with the costs of your course. There are no upfront fees to pay, your repayments don't start until the April after you complete or leave the course and your income is more than £25,000. 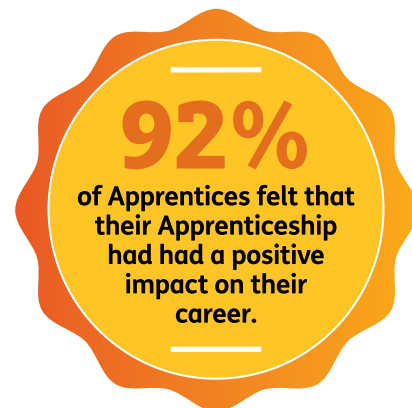

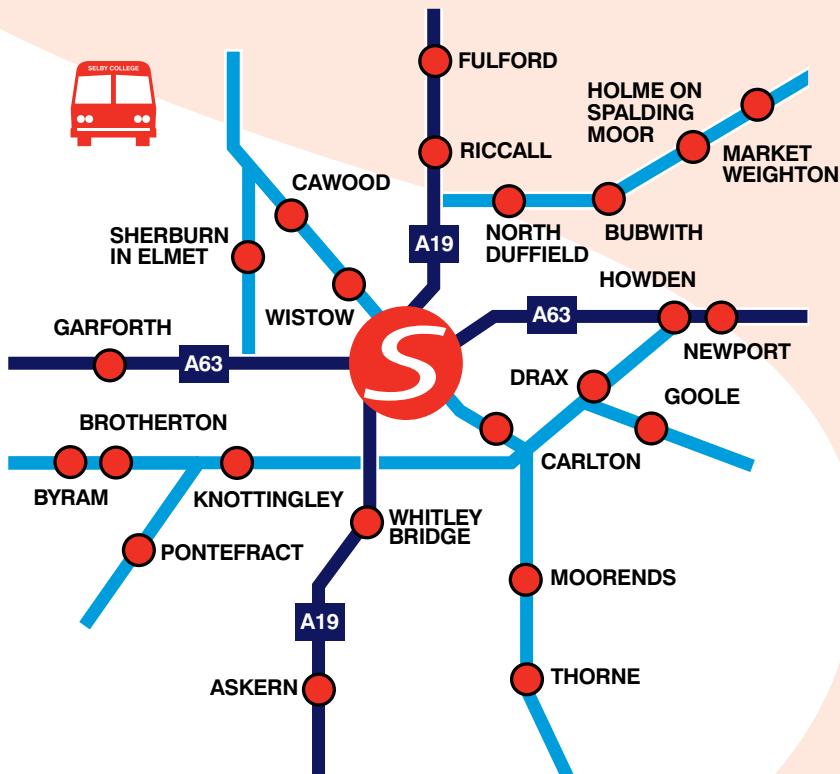
